## LITTLE JUNIOR AMATEUR GUIDELINES AND TERMS OF ENTRY

**ELIGIBILITY** - Entry open to boys 7-11 and girls 7-13. A golfer's age on July 1, 2011 determines their division of competition. The field will be limited to 72 players based on order of entry.

**ENTRIES; FORM, FEE, CLOSING DATE** - All players shall apply on NJGT LITTLE JUNIOR AMATEUR forms. Forms may be obtained from the NJGT office or website, [www.njgt.org](http://www.njgt.org).

*Entry fee of \$50 must be paid by entrants that are NJGT members; all other entrants must pay a fee of \$60. Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if the NJGT (402-957-3308) is notified before the close of entries. After the close of entries, fee will be refunded in the event of injury or illness, if requested by June 25. No refund for any reason after June 25. A \$15 service charge will be deducted from all refunds.*

**ENTRY APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY NJGT NO LATER THAN 5 P.M. C.D.T. ON MONDAY, JUNE 20, 2011.**

Late applications are not acceptable and will be automatically rejected. Time limit for entries means time of receipt at NJGT (not time entry is sent to NJGT). Entries should be submitted early to allow ample time for delay or error in transmission. The risk of delay or error in transmission lies solely with the entrant and the NJGT shall have no liability with respect to any such delay or error and the consequences therefrom, including rejection of the entry.

**RULES OF GOLF; CLOSE OF COMPETITION** - Play will be governed by the Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA. Questions shall be settled by the Championship Committee, whose decision shall be final. Competition shall be deemed to have closed in each division when the trophy has been presented.

**CODE OF CONDUCT** - Violations of the Code of Conduct include: verbal or physical abuse of any person, club throwing, cheating, disrespect of volunteers or officials, abuse of the golf course (divots not replaced, bunkers not raked, ball marks not repaired), discarded trash not placed in proper receptacle, vandalism, not adhering to dress code or any other conduct not becoming. Competitors who violate the Code may be subject to disqualification based on Committee decision. Players and parents should always conduct themselves in a professional manner while on site. Under no circumstances will displays of temper, by players or parents, either verbally or physically, be tolerated. Such acts may result in permanent suspension of all parties involved for the duration of the tournament and possibly future tournaments. Other complaints or violations not specifically covered will be reviewed by the Committee which will determine final action.

**DRESS CODE** - **Proper attire is required** on the golf course and in all practice areas. The dress code **prohibits shoes with metal spikes**, short shorts, tank tops, halter-tops, **bare midriffs**, T-shirts, denim shorts and jeans, and headphones. All hats and caps must be worn properly; collared shirts, turtlenecks or mock turtles may be worn and must be tucked in (girls may wear a collarless shirt if it is part of a coordinated outfit). Offensive slogans, language and/or pictures on clothing will not be tolerated.

**GOLF BALLS** - Only brands of golf balls on the most current USGA List of Conforming Golf Balls may be used. This list is updated monthly and may be found on the USGA web site at [www.usga.org](http://www.usga.org) or by contacting the USGA technical Department at (908) 234-2300.

**CADDIES** - A player may provide his own caddie.

**TRANSPORTATION** - Players must walk at all times during a stipulated round. The optional condition prescribed in Appendix I of *The Rules of Golf* will be in effect. Exception - Players and parents in Sunday's Parent-Child event may use transportation.

**SCORING** - Caddy may assist in counting and recording scores. **Players are limited to 12 strokes per hole, including whiffs.** Each competitor should wait at Scorer's Table until his/her card has been checked and competitor is dismissed by the Committee. All tournament scores for NJGT members will be posted for handicap purposes. Players should not post these scores individually.

**SPECTATORS** - **Spectators are welcome** and may follow players but **should not communicate with them** in any manner at any time during the competition. Clapping and encouragement for good play are allowed as long as it does not interfere with tournament play. Contestants are reminded of Rule 8-1 concerning advice and receiving assistance: Penalty two strokes. Contestants are responsible for actions of parents/spectators and are reminded that significant contact/conversation may be construed as advice. Spectators are requested to **turn off** cell phones on the golf course during competition.

**TIME OF STARTING** - The optional condition for time of starting prescribed in Appendix I of *The Rules of Golf* will be in effect.

**TIES** - Ties for first place ONLY in each division shall be decided by a hole-by-hole playoff immediately following conclusion of play.

**PUBLICITY AND PROMOTION** - By submitting an application, the player agrees to allow the NJGT to use the player's photographic/video image for any NJGT media related use(s).

**PRACTICE PRIVILEGES** - Contestants that do not compete in the parent-child are entitled to one (1) complimentary practice round. Additional practice rounds are available for a fee at the discretion of the host facility.

**CONDITIONS; SCHEDULES** - The LITTLE JUNIOR AMATEUR Tournament Committee reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The decision of the Tournament Committee in any matter shall be final.

**TOURNAMENT INFORMATION** - A memo to contestants including groupings and starting times will be e-mailed after the close of entries. If you have not received a memo within four days of the Championship, it is your responsibility to contact the NJGT.
